



Monrovia, Liberia September 27, 2018/Robinson: The Liberia Telecommunications Authority (LTA) Due Diligence Officer Willie Benson is urging radio station owners in rural Liberia to refrain from operating without referencing the LTA for frequency allocation and assignment.

Speaking at the end of the second phase of LTA's nation-wide fact finding trip to Region Two of the three FM regions across Liberia, he said many of the stations visited by the LTA team are not registered with the regulatory entity.

He however said those in this category are being encouraged to regularize their status and stop doing business without the knowledge of the LTA.

Region Two of the FM regions across the country comprises Lofa, Bong and Nimba counties.
