Summary of Responsibilities:

Installs, maintains and supports the LTA's personal computers, LAN/WAN networks, website/hosting, and Intranet/Internet. This includes PC and network equipment, systems and application software, and connectivity issues. This position also monitors, manages and reports on critical systems issues including disaster recovery and protocols on the company network. This position prepares computer hardware and software for use, including user setup configuration. This position reports directly to the IT Section.

- Provides technical assistance to staff in the use of computer hardware and software
- Installs, updates and documents company approved software as required to meet LTA's business needs.
- Responds to requests answering user questions, receiving, documenting, and maintaining a record of reported trouble in a problem-tracking database; follow-up as necessary
- Interfaces with vendors/telecommunications providers as needed to ensure timely and complete service.
- Configure applications, system software, hardware, and local peripherals; diagnose and resolve various equipment problems
- Identifies and refers, if need be, unresolved hardware and software problems for resolution
- Contribute to technical documentation and FAQs in appropriate areas
- Monitor antivirus software and updates
- Maintain an adequate spare parts inventory of systems and component parts needed by users
- Develops and achieves a high degree of competence in PC systems, approved software and associated network technology.
