
SUSPENSION OF SURCHARGES ON INTERNATIONAL CALLS BETWEEN LIBERIA AND SIERRA LEONE AND LIBERIA AND THE GAMBIA

The Liberia Telecommunications Authority (LTA) hereby gives notice to all licensed telecommunications service providers that pursuant to LTA-ORDER: 0018-01-15-20 on the implementation of free roaming on public mobile communications networks in the ECOWAS region, and the LTA Notice of December 13, 2024, suspending surcharges on international calls, the LTA has concluded Memoranda of Understanding (MOU) with the National Communications Authority (NATCA) of Sierra Leone and the Public Utility Regulatory Authority (PURA) of the Gambia for the implementation of ECOWAS Regulation C/REG 21/12/17.

Pursuant thereto, the LTA gives notice:

1. That surcharges are hereby suspended on all international calls originating from or terminated into Liberia to/from Sierra Leone and the Gambia as of the effective "Go Live" dates of the respective Memoranda of Understanding with NATCA of Sierra Leone (2nd May 2025) and PURA of the Gambia (1st July 2025);
2. That a Monitoring Committee hereinafter known as "the Committee" has been established for the purpose of monitoring and evaluating the implementation of the Memoranda of Understanding between the countries as provided for in Sections 2, 7, 9, 12, and 14 of the bilateral MOUs.
3. That the effective dates for the suspension of surcharges are 2nd May 2025 for Sierra Leone and 1st July 2025 for the Gambia; same being the effective Go-Live-Dates of their respective Memoranda of Understanding. *Final*


